Open blister pack where indicated.

Insert the Instillagel® nozzle into the Instillaquill® opening and remove from blister pack.



Open vagina by use of a speculum and insert Instillaquill[®] into the cervical canal.

It may be necessary to apply an atraumatic

forcep to the anterior lip of the cervix to locate the external cervical os in line with the vagina.



Prime Instillaquill® with gel.

Introduce Instillaquill® to a point where the collar on the tube reaches the neck of the cervix.



Withdrawal.

Slowly withdraw Instillaquill® whilst at the same time injecting sufficient gel at a steady rate to coat the cervical canal. On completion remove
